

EHF Club Ranking — Calculation

To establish the EHF Club Ranking, the most recent three seasons in the EHF Club Competitions are considered. Each club earns points based on its results within the EHF Champions League, EHF European League and/or EHF European Cup. Points are earned for winning a round within the competition and by winning or drawing in matches during the season. A win earns 2 points, while a draw earns 1 point. The table below shows the bonus points that can be earned for winning in a certain round within the different competitions (approved by the EHF Executive Committee starting from the 2002/03 season):

Additional principles:

- Teams starting in a competition at a later stage receive the maximum points they could have earned (match and bonus points), starting from the first round that was actually played.
- In case two or more teams have the same total number of points, those teams who earned more points in the more recent season will be ranked first.
